






QUESTION #7

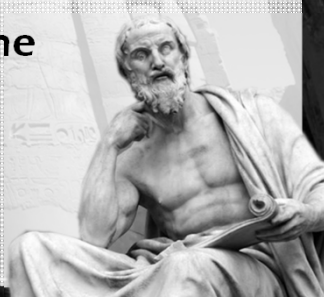
QUESTION #9, 10


QUESTION #11
