## Clarification of Criteria Terms

---

### Exegetical Accuracy (including Christocentricity)

**Was the text accurately presented including translational issues, historical context, and it's application to Christ.?**

---

### Doctrinal Substance

**Were there Doctrinal indicatives presented for each imperative given?  
Were there proper scriptural supports for each doctrinal indicative?**

---

### Clear Structure

**Was the message clearly presented with a structure that was understandable, and memorable?**

---

### Vivid Illustration

**Did the illustrations support the applications and did they draw in the listener?**

---

### Pointed Application

**Were there applications that are clear, achievable and supportable by the text and message**

---

### Helpful Delivery

**Eye contact, Pacing, Varied voice - pitch, meter and volume ; Appropriate Hand Jesters; and facial features.**

### Supernatural Authority

**What was the authority used for the message – was it Logic, Carl's smarts, or was it the Holy Spirit enabling God's Word.**
