



I. Actions preceding Dinner (26:1-16)

I.A. The fourth Prediction (26:1-2)

Matthew 26:2 (ESV) 2 "You know that after two days the Passover is coming, and the Son of Man will be delivered up to be crucified."

I.B. The Plots (26:3-5, 14-16)



I.B.1. Caiaphas plots (3-5)

to arrest Jesus secretly,
then to Kill him, not during the feast.

I.B.2. Judas plots with religious leaders (14-16)

to betray for 30 pieces of silver



I.C. The preparation (26:6-13) Jesus is anointed by woman at Bethany

I.C.1. the dedication (26:6-7)
Woman pours expensive perfume on Jesus

I.C.2. The denunciation (26:8-9)
Disciples criticize the waste of the perfume, they claim it should have been sold.

I.C.3. The defense (26:10-13) Jesus give 2 reasons

I.C.3.a. The preparation aspect (10-12) She did this to prepare his body for burial

I.C.3.b. The prophetic aspect (13) her act will be remembered where ever the gospel is taught.

II.A. The Instructions (26:17-19) Jesus directs two of his disciples to prepare a room in Jerusalem for the Passover

II.B.1. Jesus announces one of the 12 (20-24) disciples will betray him

II.B.2. Jesus discretely reveals (25) Judas as the betrayer

They sing a song and then go out to Mount of Olives.



The 4 Cups of the Seder

1. At the beginning, Opening
1st Promise, *I will bring you out.*
2. Before eating,
2nd Promise, *I will set you free.*

The Meal is eaten here.

1. After eating,
3rd Promise, *I will redeem you.*
2. Before Leaving,
4th Promise, *I will take you to myself.*

Exodus 6: 6–7 (ESV)

⁶Say therefore to the people of Israel, ‘I am the LORD, and I will bring you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians, and I will deliver you from slavery to them, and I will redeem you with an outstretched arm and with great acts of judgment.

⁷I will take you to be my people, and I will be your God, and you shall know that I am the LORD your God, who has brought you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians.

Luke 22: 14–20 (ESV)

¹⁴And when the hour came, he reclined at table, and the apostles with him. ¹⁵And he said to them, “I have earnestly desired to eat this Passover with you before I suffer. ¹⁶For I tell you I will not eat it until it is fulfilled in the kingdom of God.”

¹⁷And he took the cup, said, “This cup is for you,” and he drank from it.

¹⁸And he took the bread, said, “This is my body,” and he broke the bread and gave it to them, and they ate.

²⁰And he took the cup, said, “This cup is for you,” and he drank from it.
