
I.B.I. Caiaphas plots (3-5)

They sing a song and then go out to Mount of Olives.

The 4 Cups of the Seder

- 1. At the beginning, Opening 1st Promise, *I will bring you out.*
- 2. Before eating, 2nd Promise, *I will set you free*.

The Meal is eaten here.

- 1. After eating, 3rd Promise, *I will redeem you*.
- 2. Before Leaving, 4th Promise, *I will take you to myself.*
