III.B. Prayers of Jesus (26:36-46)

III.B.1. Jesus seeks assistance (36-38)

Requests Peter, James & John to accompany him.

III.B.2. The Agony He suffers

III.B.2.a. His first Prayer (39-41)



III.B.2.a.i. The Struggle (39) Jesus begs his Father to remove the coming suffering but emphasizes that he desires to do the fathers will, not his own.

III.B.2.a.ii. The Sleepers (40–42) Returning. Jesus finds Peter, James and John sleeping' asks them to keep watch.

III.B.2.b. His second prayer

III.B.2.b.i. The Struggle (42) Similar to first prayer

III.B.2.b.ii. The Sleepers (43) Returning, Jesus again finds them sleeping, and implores them to keep watch.

III.B.3.c. His Third prayer

III.B.2.c.i. The Struggle (44) Similar to first prayer

III.B.2.c.ii. The Sleepers (45–46) Returning, Jesus finds them sleeping, awakens them, and warns of the imminent arrest.

III.C. The Persecutions begin (26:47–56a, 57–68)

III.C.1. Jesus is arrested (47-56)

III.C.1.a. Jesus and Judas (47–50a) Judas betrays with a KISS

III.C.l.b. Jesus and Peter (50b-54) *Peter rebuked for* cutting off the ear of the High Priests servant.

III.C.1.c. Judas and the soldiers (55–56a) *Jesus* reminds the arresting soldiers and crowds of his innocence.

III.C.2. Religious Leaders accuse Jesus (27:57-66)

III.C.2.a. The attempts (57–61)

III.C.2.a.i. They search for false witnesses (57–59)

III.C.2.a.ii. Their efforts are futile and fail to locate false witnesses against Jesus (60-61)

No two people sgree in their testimony.

III..C.2.b. Jesus affirms to the high priest (62-64) He is indeed the messiah.

III.C.2.c. The Sanhedrin agrees it's blasphemy and votes to put Jesus to death. (65–66)

III.C.3. Jesus is assaulted by the Jewish leaders who spit on and strike him (67–68)
