I.A. The action preceding this appearance (28:1-8)

I.A.I. Mary Magdalene and Mary arrive at tomb (1)

I.A.2. An Angel beside the tomb (2-8)

I.A.2.a. He shines like lightening (2-4)
(Causes Guards to become as dead men for fear)

I.A.2.b. He announces resurrection of Jesus (5–6)

I.A.2.c. He tells the women to tell the apostles (7–8) (and tell them they will meet in Galilee).

I.C. The action following this appearance (28:11-15)

I.C.I. The frightened guards tell the chief priests (11)

I.C.2. The guards agree to tell a story (12–15) for a promise they will be taken care of.

They claim the Disciples stole his body while they were sleeping.

Note: For a Roman Soldier to fall asleep on duty Was as good as a death sentence.
