- 1. The daughters were beautiful, and plentiful (6:1)
- 2. The Sons of God freely took them to wife (6:2)

Who were the Sons of God?



- 3. God decrees a limit in human lifetime OR possibly a delay in punishment . . (6:3)
- 4. The Naphilim took wives and had "giants" (6:4)
- 5. God Sees evil on the whole earth, and decides to end it.

               The flood prevails 150 days, mountains covered (7:17-24)

              The flood recedes 150 days mountains visible (8:1-5)
           The earth dries (8:6-14)
        God commands the remnant to leave the ark (8:15-19)
    Noah builds an altar (8:20)
God resolves not to destroy hhumankind (8:21-22)
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11.6 The Noahic Covenant(9:1-17)

11.C The Noahic Covenant (9:1-17)

- 1. God directs to be Fruitful & Multiply (9:1)
- 2. God reorders the food chain (9:2-4)
- 3. Life will be required of a life taker (9:5-6)
- 4. God repeats, be Fruitful & Multiply (9:7)
- 5. God Covenants with Noah and Creation
 - a. Never again will | destroy all life by a flood (9:8-11)
 - b. My sign in the sky, the rainbow (9:12-17)
- 6. Noah's three sons (9:18-19)
 Shem, Ham, and Japheth Fathers to the world.

II.D Noah's Drunkenness (9:20-29)

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- 1. Noah was naked, and in a drunken state (9:20-21)
- 2. Ham saw him, and went out telling all (9:22-24)
- 3. Noah's prophecy / curse (9:25-29)

But why curse Canaan, son of Ham...



Views on why Noah cursed Canaan

- 1. Ham's punishment was transferred to Canaan . (Ham is blessed 9:1)
- 2. Ham is cursed, not Canaan (Should be understood to mean cursed be the father of Canaan)
- 3. Canaan cursed for his own sin He was an accessory to his father's sin.
- 4. Canaan's descendants cursed, not Canaan himself. Noah saw in Canaan the evil traits of his father, Ham. This moral abandon was seen in the people of Canaan, the descendants of Canaan.
