- <sup>29</sup> Are all apostles? *(no)*  
 Are all prophets? *(no)*  
 Are all teachers? *(no)*  
 Do all work miracles? *(no)*  
<sup>30</sup> Do all possess gifts of healing? *(no)*  
 Do all speak with tongues? *(no)*  
 Do all interpret? *(no)*
- <sup>31</sup> But earnestly desire the higher gifts.  
 And I will show you a still more excellent way.

## Matthew 28:19-20, Acts 1, 8 (ESV)

- <sup>19</sup> Go therefore and *make* disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, <sup>20</sup> teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age."
- <sup>8</sup> But you will *receive* power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will *be* my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth."
