



Gospel Encounter:


John MacArthur presents the Gospel Encounter model of spiritual warfare. Unbelievers can be demonized and it is only through the Gospel Message, and accepting of salvation that demons can be evicted. A believer can never be demon possessed and God has given us spiritual armor (Eph 6) for believers to successfully defeat Satan's attacks on them.

Power Encounter


Karl Payne proposes that believers through sin and several other means can give demons a legal basis for co-indwelling believers. A believer can exercise authority over these demons and evict them but to do it you will need to dialogue with the demon to identify the appropriate sin which gave the demon grounds for indwelling and then by prayer of confession the demon(s) can then by name be evicted.


