
## **PROVERBS 3:1-12 (ESV)**

## MEMORY VERSE, #2 ROMANS 10:8A-13 (ESV)

8 But what does it say? ... 9because, if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.  
10For with the heart one believes and is justified, and with the mouth one confesses and is saved.  
11For the Scripture says, "Everyone who believes in him will not be put to shame."  
12For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek; for the same Lord is Lord of all, bestowing his riches on all who call on him.  
13For "everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved."

**28** And one of the scribes came up and ... asked him,  
"Which commandment is the most important of all?"

**29** Jesus answered,  
"The most important is,  
'Hear, O Israel:  
The Lord our God, the Lord is one. (Deut 6:4-5)

**30** And you shall love the Lord your God  
with all your heart and  
with all your soul and  
with all your mind and  
with all your strength.

**31** The second is this:  
"You shall love your neighbor as (Lev 19:18b)  
yourself.  
There is no other commandment  
greater than these."
